Workshop 2: Anti-Corruption Advocacy and Strategies

Public Speaking sessions

4. Debating with Integrity

Focusing on advocacy and community involvement, this session will equip participants with techniques for delivering persuasive speeches that encourage civic participation, volunteerism, and community service.

6. Elevator Pitch for Ethical Leadership and Entrepreneurship

In this session, participants will develop short, impactful pitches that communicate their vision for ethical leadership or integrity-driven business ideas regarding their personal action plan..
